- No electronic gadgets not even a torch!






You <u>DO NOT</u> need a sleeping bag or pillow - bedding is provided!

Children:

Do's and Don'ts!

DO

- •bring up to £15 in small change in a named wallet.
- make sure any medicine is <u>clearly marked with instructions</u> and given in the original packaging to an adult on the morning of departure (22nd October 2025).
- •Bring sensible indoor shoes
- •Bring a holdall instead of a suitcase.

DON'T

- bring sweets for the journey or any extra food at all.
- bring aerosol deodorant (it may set off the fire alarm)
- bring mobile phones, <u>cameras</u>...electronic games/toys etc.
- bring jewellery or make-up same rules as in school.



Forms to complete

- Food Allergies Form required by the caterers at Letton Hall.
- NHS number (GP)
- On the day, medication needs to be handed in with clear administration instructions.
